There is no greater priority than protecting your farm, your family, and your community and, all too often, you may not feel you have received the support to enable you to do that.

I have secured £548,980 from the Home Office to invest in the security of homes and farms in your area to make sure that you are safer and feel safer.

You can get **free security survey and upgrades** to your farm as part of this scheme.

Funding is available for the following:

- **Provide every farm in the area with a perimeter alarm system** to give early warning of intruders.
- **To upgrade the security of homes which fall below 'Secure by Design' standards by looking at what can be improved and then paying for this to be put into place**
- **To work with landowners, farmers and local construction companies to bund fields (construct banks) around vulnerable areas of villages** – the aim of this is to stop access across them to the rear of properties, with the added benefit of preventing crop damage and poaching. This has proved highly successful elsewhere in the country.
- **To provide detailed security and crime prevention advice** - which you can find in this pack, to help you protect your farm.

To apply for your free farm security survey

- Please take five minutes to read the *Protect Your Farm* scheme information booklet
- Using the checklist in the leaflet, think about whether you are eligible for a security upgrade, most of you will be.
- If you think you are, or are not sure, please contact us.
- My team will then arrange for our approved provider to visit you, undertake the survey and upgrade your security.
