To proactively commission research and insight to better understand public satisfaction, and coordinate the ongoing management of public feedback related to the Police and Crime Plan and Fire and Rescue Plan.
Develop successful policy initiatives supporting policing and crime and fire and rescue services in North Yorkshire, including alongside the Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner at a national level
To lead and oversee specific performance, standards and scrutiny work and projects
To ensure the provision of comprehensive professional advice in relation to those functions contained in the Policy and Scrutiny team for all service areas of North Yorkshire Police and North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service.
To represent and make decisions on behalf of the Commissioner in performance, scrutiny and standards matters as required and in other settings as necessary.
To monitor individual budgets to reduce costs and enhance value in service delivery.
To lead the continuous development of the Policy and Scrutiny operating environment and ensure it remains fit for purpose and is representative of the robust and comprehensive standards agenda required by the Commissioner.
To continually promote engagement and awareness at management and operational levels, taking cognisance of external developments.
To ensure effective systems of governance are in place to identify, mitigate, manage, accept risks associated with the delivery of the Police and Crime Plan and Fire and Rescue Plan.
To manage the performance of teams.
To develop and implement policies and procedures to ensure best practice and adherence to corporate and statutory governance.
To prepare (and oversee preparation of) the Police and Crime Plan and Fire and Rescue Plan, annual reports, papers for associated governance meetings/boards and to present and be answerable for policy and scrutiny matters in connection with such papers.

	To attend and participate in such governance meetings/working groups as the Commissioner and CEO reasonably require. As lead policy and scrutiny advisor, to critically assess obstacles to performance as well as opportunities across the full range of functions within the organisation. You will be working in a public office, which means there is particular scrutiny on the performance of the Police and Crime Commissioner and their office. You will therefore be expected to uphold the highest standards of personal integrity and conduct, abiding by the Nolan Principles of Standards in Public Life.
