But it is also well connected, and we all know that brings opportunities for criminals that can make this community a target. That is why I chose to put forward your community to benefit from this investment.

North Yorkshire Police's local Neighbourhood Policing Team have been working hard to support and protect residents and the Rural Taskforce has been working closely with the farming community to help protect their valuable property. However, the road network of this area, criss-crossed by a network of small roads linking to main roads – means that the area remains vulnerable, and criminals are often long clear before the police have even been notified.

The funding is available for the following:

- **To upgrade the security of homes, farms and smallholdings which fall below 'Secure by Design' standards by looking at what can be improved and then paying for this to be put into place** – please see the enclosed scheme information leaflet to find out if you are eligible.
- **To provide detailed security and crime prevention advice** - which you can find in this pack, to help you protect yourselves.

North Yorkshire Police will also purchase additional Automatic Number Plate Recognition cameras and upgrade Rural Watch Signage in specific locations to detect and deter potential burglars.

Get involved, take advantage of this opportunity to protect your home by arranging your free home security survey now.

All we need you to do is take five minutes to read the further information about the scheme, check your locks for the 'Secure by Design' kitemark, and think about whether you are eligible. Most of you will be.

If you think you are, or aren't sure, please contact us. My team will then arrange for our approved provider to visit you, undertake the survey and upgrade your home security.
