- The use of custody for 136 detentions is required where detainees pose a risk to themselves or others, or after consultation with partners there is no capacity within health based place of safety. Every use of custody for a 136 detention is scrutinised.
- The Place of Safety at Bootham Park Hospital closed at the end of September as part of the wider closure of the hospital due to serious safety concerns. As an interim measure, 24-hour Mental Health "Street" Triage has been put in place to cover York, Selby, Tadcaster and Easingwold and a presence in the Force Control Room.
- The number of occurrences with a mental health qualifier remain under represented. This is one of the focus areas for the Police Knowledge Fund research with University of York, who will be reviewing our processes (along with good practice elsewhere) to help determine how we can improve in this regard.
