- Police custody must only be used for s.136 MHA detainees in highly exceptional circumstances, e.g. genuinely unmanageable risks of resistance, aggression, violence or escape, or if also detained for an offence. Every use of custody in these circumstances is scrutinised.
- **In November 2015, for the first time in at least seven years*, there were no custodial s.136 MHA detentions.**
- The number of occurrences with a mental health qualifier remain under represented. This is one of the focus areas for the Police Knowledge Fund research with University of York, who will be reviewing our processes (along with good practice elsewhere) to help determine how we can improve in this regard.
