As of 4.00pm on the 31st January, the consultation response is as follows:

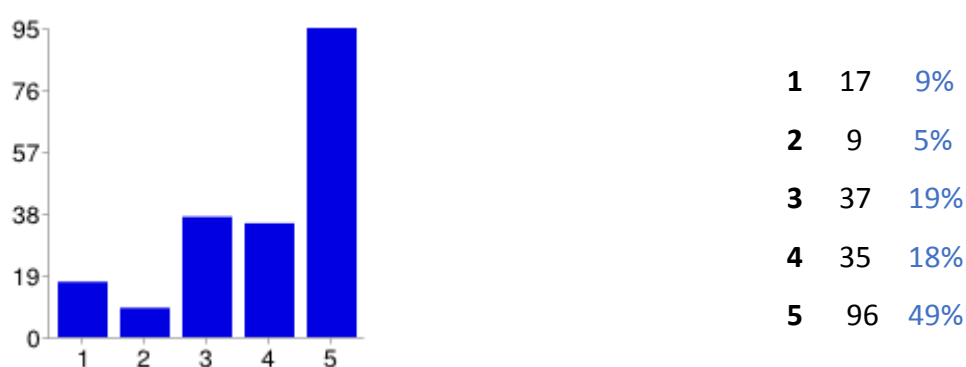
There were **199 responses**

To what extent do you agree with the following statement?

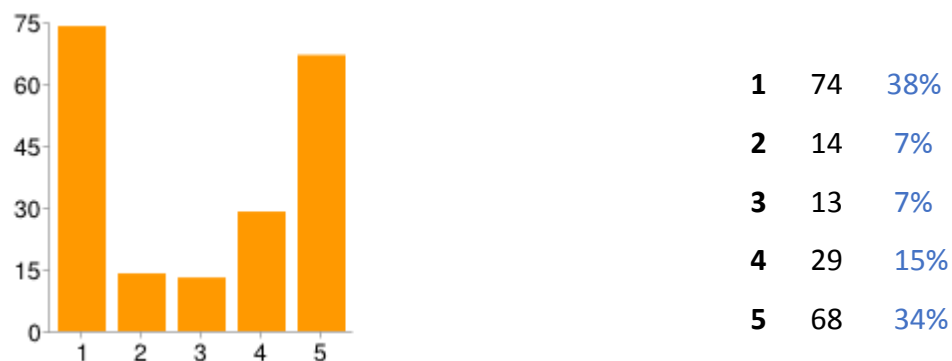
I think it is important to maintain the number of police officers serving in North Yorkshire



67% of respondents either agree or strongly agree that it is important to maintain the number of police officers serving in North Yorkshire

To what extent do you agree with the following statement?

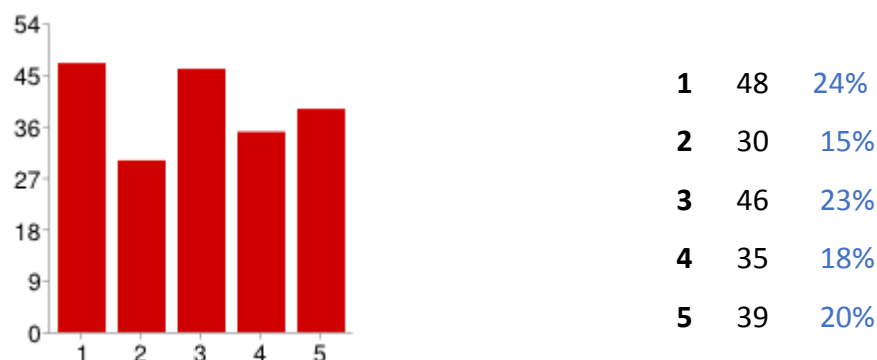
I would be willing to pay an average of an extra £4.07 a year in my council tax to help maintain officer numbers



49% of respondents either agree or strongly agree that they would be willing to pay an average of an extra £4.07 a year in my council tax to help maintain officer numbers, compared to 45% who either strongly disagree or disagree

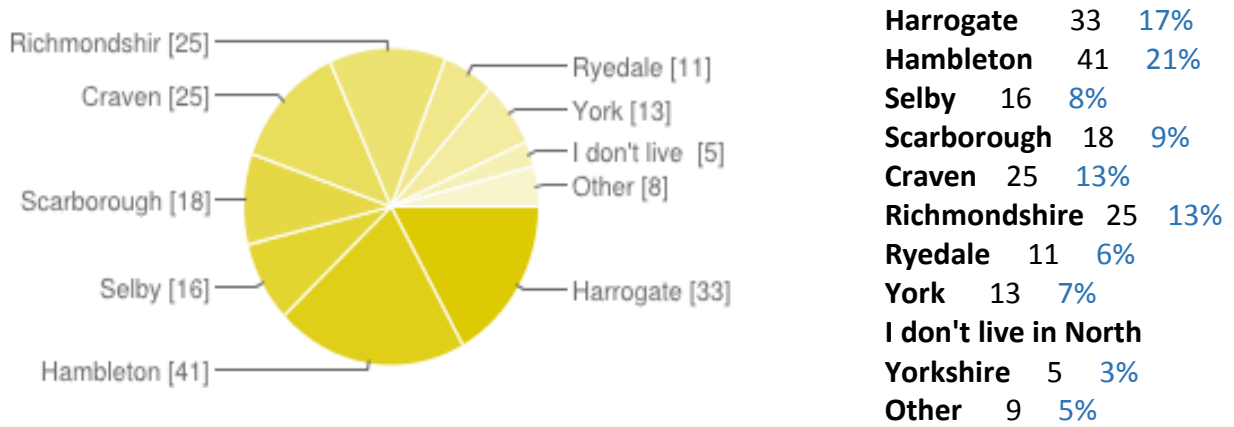
To what extent do you agree with the following statement?
