Introduction

Within North Yorkshire and the City of York there are over 6,000 miles of roads, used every day by a variety of people for many reasons - from commuting and tourism to committing crime.

The substantial size of the force area means that we must consider our road networks as a geographical neighbourhood in themselves, with their own set of people, priorities, issues and crimes. Some road users may be only travelling through our county, but their activities can have a serious impact at the heart of our communities.

The public have informed us through extensive research and consultation as part of the priority setting for the current Police and Crime Plan, that a significant percentage of those consulted, namely 80%*, are concerned about road safety in their local areas and that this is a priority area for them.

The ability of North Yorkshire Police to effectively and efficiently respond to the wide spectrum of requirements is essential to build on our reputation and address those areas of response that require additional focus. The resources and tactics used must be skilled and innovational to continue our support to the well-established 95 Alive partnership working and continued commitment to the Police and Crime Plan 2013 - 2016. Our response to policing the roads must embrace the bedrock of neighbourhood policing of access, influence, interventions and answers and be impactive on criminals using our roads. Investment in new technology will continue to support the development of our response to ensure the most appropriately skilled and equipped resources are deployed now and in the future.

Policing the roads in North Yorkshire is diverse and a challenge, but one we have the ability to co-ordinate on as an organisation and make a real difference to all sections of our community.


