They are there for the benefit of the public and officers alike, the cameras will only be recording when an officer is attending an incident and will make it know that those involved are being recorded. If someone who it’s involved in that incident is caught on the footage technology is in place to blur out faces. The data being held from the cameras is regularly reviewed, assessed, and regulated.
