



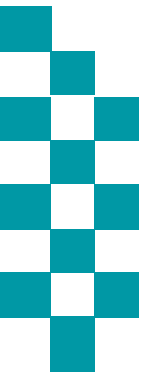

Policing update – Kirby Misperton





Overview of Operation Kingfisher

Our aim has been to ensure that North Yorkshire Police provides a consistent and co-ordinated policing response to any protest activity related to hydraulic fracturing (fracking), fulfilling our core responsibilities and conducting ourselves in a manner compatible with our values and the Code of Ethics:

- facilitating fundamental human rights around peaceful protest by supporting and protecting those engaging in it, and taking account of their rights to freedom of expression, assembly and association.
- balancing the needs and rights of the wider public, local communities (residential, visiting, and business) and the rights of all, including the energy companies, to go about lawful and peaceful activities.

A full review of the Operation is being undertaken, as we are keen to take on board any lessons learnt by seeking the views of stakeholders, including strategic partners, campaign groups and residents.



Additional costs
