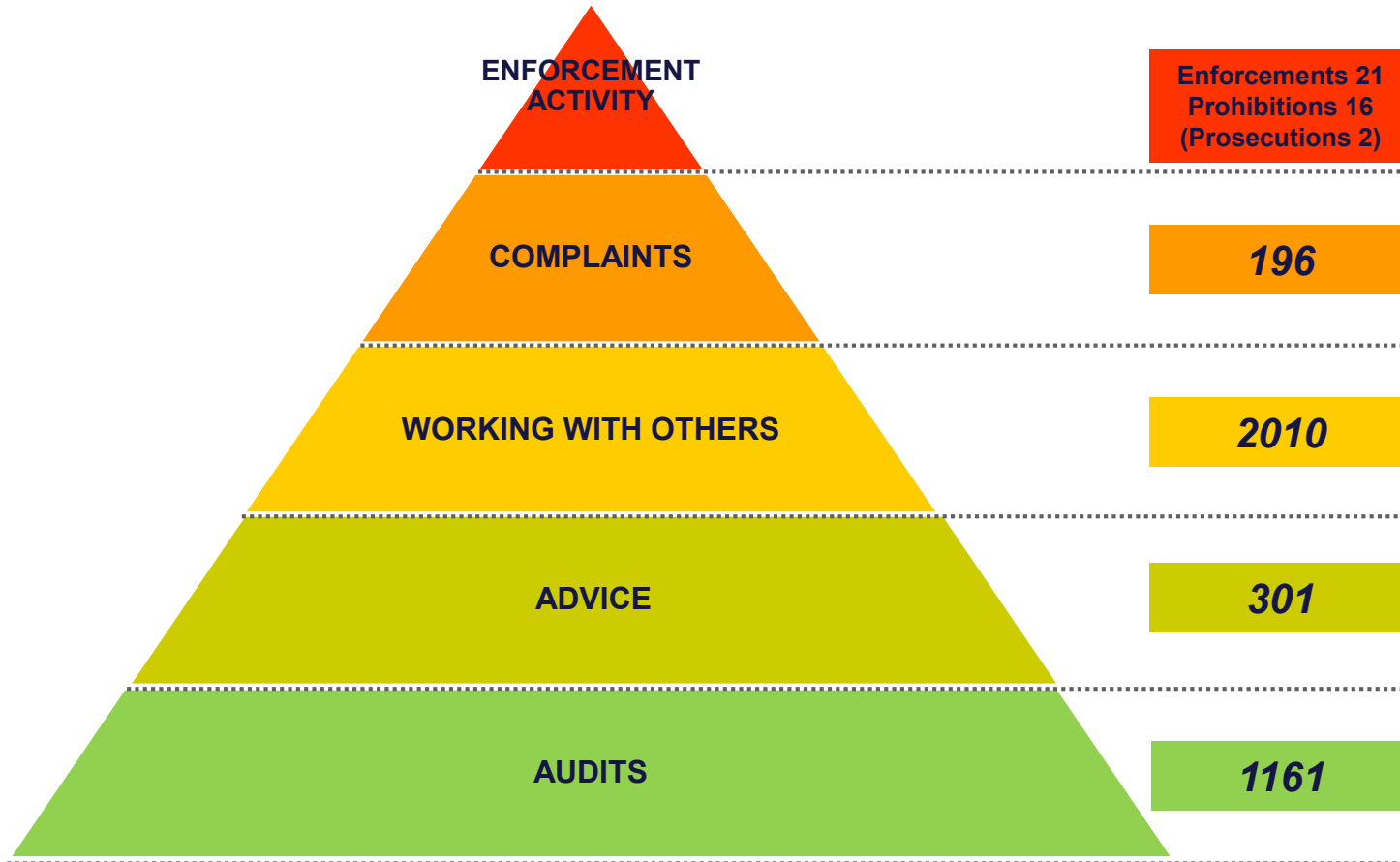

- Improve the integration between protection and prevention activities to address both regulatory and statutory needs and also of the occupier.
