Results - what we expect to achieve in the next 12 months (and beyond).

- Deliver problem solving training to NYP front line staff and appropriate partner agencies
- Use the existing estate strategy to increase number of partner agencies co-locating with NYP
- Use mental health co-ordinators to assist partnership to develop person centred step up and step down services across North Yorkshire and the City of York
- Establish strategic agreement regarding Early Help and ACEs with Local Authorities
- Deliver Two Way Interface between NYP and CPS
- Develop internal and external engagement with CJ partners to increase Trinity referrals from other organisations.
- Deliver, develop and embed Public Safety Officers
