





Developing a 'Whole Family' Approach - Support Services for children & young affected by domestic abuse

The Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner for North Yorkshire, North Yorkshire County Council and City of York Council recognise the negative impact that Domestic Abuse has on families, children and communities. They are committed to working together through collaborative commissioning arrangements for all domestic abuse support services in North Yorkshire and the City of York to provide effective and consistent support and interventions to meet the needs of all those affected by domestic abuse.

In order to achieve this vision, the Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner for North Yorkshire is inviting organisations to tender to deliver a 'Whole Family Approach' from 1st July 2021 providing support services for children & young people affected by domestic abuse in North Yorkshire and the City of York.

In addition to providing direct support to children, young people and their parent/s or guardian/s, the successful bidder will be required to work with the Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner for North Yorkshire, North Yorkshire County Council, City of York Council and other key stakeholders to significantly improve the overall evidence base of actual needs of children & young people living in households where domestic abuse occurs, and identify the most effective interventions to meet these needs and inform future service development and strategic planning.

The intention is to award any resulting Contract through an open, competitive procurement process for an initial period of 21 months (1 year & 9 months), commencing on the 1st July 2021, with an extension option of one period of 12 months from 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024.

The Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner for North Yorkshire is inviting bids up to the maximum Contract Value of £198,000 for the initial one year & nine month period.

This tender opportunity will be advertised on the Blue Light Procurement Portal, and applications must be submitted via the portal. To do this and if you are not already registered, you will need to register at https://uk.eu-supply.com
