AJ1 Road Safety Fund Background:

- AJ1 number plate = first registration number issued when vehicle number plates were introduced in 1903
- June 2019 PFCC and Chief Constable agree to sell AJ1 and invest the money raised in two projects:
 - Memorial Garden at North Yorkshire Police Headquarters
 - AJ1 Road Safety Fund

AJ1 Road Safety Fund

- Aim = strengthen the work of local communities, organisations and groups, e.g. parish councils to improve road safety across North Yorkshire
- Projects required to support 95 Alive Road Safety Partnership Strategic Priorities, focussing on Education and Engagement with priority groups:
 - Parish councils and other local groups delivering road safety initiatives in their communities
 - Children and Young People
 - Cyclists
 - Motor Cyclists
 - Older Road Users
- Sustainable, partnership applications with identified match funding encouraged
- Total AJ1 Road Safety Funding available = £190,085





AJ1 Road Safety Fund Outcomes:

- Huge demand 106 Applications = £787,567 exceeding funding available by four times
- Assessment process included checks with North Yorkshire County Council's Highways and Transportation Department to ensure viability and consultation with County Councillors
- Final decisions made by panel representatives of the 95 Alive Partnership, including the Office of the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner; North Yorkshire Police; North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC); City of York Council; and Highways England
- 81 Projects, Awarded £355,228:
 - Funding shortfall was met using underspend from other PFCC grant funds
