There is no greater priority than protecting your family, your home, and your community and, all too often, you may not feel you have received the support to enable you to do that.

Following our bid to the Home Office's Safer Streets Fund, nearly £430,000 is to be invested in a project to cut crime in the Birkin, Camblesforth, Carlton, Fairburn, Hillam, Hirst Courtney and Monk Fryston areas of Selby.

The money will benefit more than 2,000 homes and 50 farms, in an area where we know, due to its location and ease of access to the motorway network, there is a significant problem with high impact crimes such as burglary.

You can get a free survey, video door bell and security upgrades which could include a perimeter farm alarm as part of this project. The more people who take part, the safer we can make everyone and the better we can prevent crime, put off criminals and protect your home.

Funding is available for the following:

- To upgrade the security of homes which fall below 'Secure by Design' standards by looking at what can be improved and then paying for this to be put into place – please see the enclosed information to find out how to register.
- To provide detailed security and crime prevention advice which you can find in this
 pack, to help you protect yourselves.
- To work with landowners and farmers to protect farms and equipment.— in addition to improving the security of the home we will also be installing equipment to better protect farm equipment, livestock and crops.
- **Automatic Number Plate Recognition cameras** we will be installing ANPR cameras in the area to monitor vehicles travelling into the area to commit crime.
