





#### **Non-emergency Calls**















#### February 2023 was lower than the average incident levels previously seen, however a large rise in avg officers and avg mins per occ.

- 0 detainees required to be taken out of the county this month
- 6 incidents required police transportation:

   1 following a risk assessment, 1 Ambulance not available within 30 minutes,
   2 Ambulance weren't called.
- 8 incidents were transported by ambulance, 0 incidents not recorded.
- 1 method of transportation not recorded
- 26.67% of detentions resulted in Admission

The actual PCSO FTE for January increased - the highest FTE this year since May 2022. However these numbers declined in February, and the trend shows that these will likely continue to do so.


The FTE count is still well below the budget and that trend follows again next month.
