As the published statement makes clear, the Chief has announced that she'll retire on 31 March 2024, well in advance of that date. No vacancy arises for the time being, so no decision about succession arrangements is necessary or appropriate at this early stage. My responsibilities are governed by detailed legal provisions. In any case, as I'm sure you will understand, as the holder of the public office of PFCC I can only discuss the topic of succession arrangements with those who advise me professionally.
