



Non-emergency Calls (Rolling 12 months)








The national standards for response times are: Immediate Urban – 15mins / Immediate Rural – 20mins / Priority – 60mins.

90 Day Data - Incident volumes by District (05/07/2023 – 01/10/2023)







3 Year Crime Trend (Period: 01st October 2020 – 30 September 2023)














Budget Target for FTE remains at 1645.00 in 23/24, but we are still also tracking headcount closely as a requirement for additional funding from the Home Office.

Headcount target is therefore 1675.

We are currently on track to achieve both targets, and potentially exceed them.




