SOS+ is an award-winning extension to St Giles' award-winning SOS gangs project. Our approach uses trained professionals to equip children and young people to think critically, assess risk and make better life choices, making them more resilient to the risks of becoming involved in gangs, exploitation and violence.

# HARD HITTING, EFFECTIVE

SOS+ puts trained staff with lived experience at the heart of the solution. Having once been involved in gangs, exploitation and violence themselves, staff are imbued with a passion and collective desire to ensure the young people they work with do not make the same mistakes they once did.

### WHO IS IT FOR?

**Age range:** is 10-25 years. **Target:** Children and young adults at risk of exploitation or frequently missing from home.
