

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS IN RELATION TO THE STATEMENT OF
ACCOUNTS OF THE CHIEF CONSTABLE OF NORTH YORKSHIRE FOR THE
FINANCIAL YEAR 2024/25 (7th May 2024 TO 31st MARCH 2025)**

NOTICE is given that from Wednesday 13th August 2025 to Wednesday 24th September 2025 between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm any persons interested may inspect and make copies of the accounts of the Chief Constable for the period ended 31 March 2025 and the supporting documents thereto. This right can be found in the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 (as amended by the York and North Yorkshire Combined Authority Order 2023).

The Act also provides any persons interested, or any journalist, with the right to inspect the accounting records and all related documents for that financial year.

The accounts will be available for inspection at the offices at which they are normally kept, or otherwise by arrangement. Application should be made initially to Naomi Eastwood, Finance Manager and Deputy Section 151 Officer, Police Headquarters, Alverton Court, Crosby Road, Northallerton, DL6 1BF or by email at naomi.eastwood@northyorkshire.police.uk.

NOTICE is also given that from Wednesday 13th August 2025 to Wednesday 24th September 2025, any local government elector, or representative of the elector, is given the opportunity to question the auditor about the accounting records for the same financial year, and make objection to the auditor if it concerns:

- a matter of which the auditor could make a report in the public interest under Section 24 of the Act; or
- an item of account in respect of which the auditor could apply for a declaration that the item is unlawful under section 28 of the Act.
